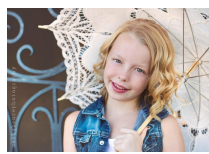
This cause is particularly close to our hearts. The son of one of our AFPA families was diagnosed as an infant with autism. Your donation provides his family with hope.

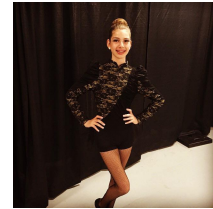


Taylor Welling - AFPA Performance Team Member
