REQUIREMENTS

Competition Team Fee Due by June 17th: \$300

Mini Competition Team:

2 Ballet, 1 Jazz, 1 Tap, 1 Hip-Hop, 1 Acro, Competition rehearsals (Musical Theater and Contemporary are not required but highly recommended.)

Any rehearsals scheduled as needed.

Junior, Teen & Senior Team:

2-3 Ballet, 1 Jazz, 1 Tap, 1 Hip-Hop, 1 Acro, and Competition rehearsals scheduled as needed.

(Musical Theater and Contemporary are not required but highly recommended.)

Mandatory training requirements:

Master Class Weekend – Sept. 23rd-25th, 2016

The Pulse/Camp Pulse- Las Vegas- October 14-16, 2016

4-5 Conventions and/or Competitions –

The Pulse/Camp Pulse –Phoenix –January 27th-29th

Velocity Dance Convention-Phoenix-February 17th-19th

Hollywood Connection- Phoenix- April 7-9, 2017

Summer 2017 is a Nationals year! Nationals and Summer Intensive are Mandatory and will include rehearsals. Which Nationals we attend will be decided AFTER we attend the regional conventions throughout the season

Mandatory performances:

End of year Company Showcase Tuesday May 30th- Sunday June 4th

Possible other performances and/or community service projects with sufficient notice

Optional training and performing opportunities:

Master classes – Guest teachers, as well as extra Dance Conventions are made available by AFPA throughout the year. These events are encouraged and some master classes will be required at an extra cost with sufficient notice.

FUNDRAISING:

The G-Force Dance Company is a 501-C3 organization that does fundraisers throughout the year to help families pay for dance-related activities.

Any family with a dancer selected to join the G-Force Dance Company, will be able to take part in any and all fundraising the group does.

GRADES:

All dancers must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Non-negotiable.

Dancers are required to turn in report cards each quarter (or semester) and if they are not maintaining a 3.0, they will be put on probation –

1st problem will result in a loss of breaks. Dancer will not be allowed to leave the studio for food/snacks. Dancer will have to sit in our office and complete any/all homework until grades are brought up.

2nd problem will result in a loss of performance. Dancer will be removed from every performance until grades are brought up.

3rd problem will result in removal from Competition. Dancer will not be allowed to participate in any Competition rehearsal or competition until grades are pulled up. Dancer will be removed for good if it's two consecutive grading periods.

These rules are NON-NEGOTIABLE.
