Covid-19 Procedures

At Adaptive Force Performing Arts, we strive to provide a clean and safe environment for your dancer. To limit the amount of foot traffic in the studio, we ask that, unless your child is under the age of 6, you drop-off and do not stay in the studio. AFPA will soon release a list of "watch weeks" in which you will be invited to view your dancer's classes.

Please send your dancer with their own water, as our water fountains are temporarily turned off. We kindly ask that you have your dancer's hair pulled back and out of their face for class - this way, they are less likely to touch their faces. Below is a breakdown of your dancer's timeline for their dance day.



Dancers should enter at the front of the studio.

Dancers will have their temperature taken when they arrive.



Sanitation stations are located throughout the studio.

Dancers will be properly distanced in classes.



Dancers are encouraged to wash their hands between classes.

Studios will be wiped down between classes.



Dancers should be picked up at the back of the studio.
